

DOG POOL BUYING & DESIGN CHECKLIST

QUICK START (READ FIRST)

1. Define primary use (cooling / bathing / play). 2. Confirm dog size & count. 3. Decide structure (inflatable vs non-inflatable). 4. Verify material thickness & rim stability. 5. Check drainage & cleaning workflow. 6. Match surface & storage constraints.

Failure	Primary Cause	Observed Result
Rim collapse	Edge loading	Dog avoids pool / tipping risk
Puncture	Claw abrasion	Leaks / early wear
Warping	Heat / UV	Loss of shape / wobble
Odor	Poor drainage	Low reuse / hygiene issues

DECISION MATRIX (CORE)

Your Situation	Recommended Choice	Why It Works
Large dog (60+ lb)	Non-inflatable + reinforced walls	Handles rim pressure
Daily summer use	Reinforced PVC ≥ 0.45 mm	Multi-season durability
Bathing / muddy paws	Smooth wall + bottom drain	Fast cleaning
Multiple dogs	Add 20–30% width	Less bumping & tipping
Nervous / senior dogs	Stable rim + anti-slip base	Predictable feedback
Hard surface (patio)	Rubber mat + anti-slip base	Reduces sliding/abrasion

STRUCTURE & MATERIAL SNAPSHOT

Behavior note: dogs load the rim (front paws + lean + step-out). Inflatable walls compress under edge load; non-inflatable relies on material stiffness + reinforced walls for stable feedback. For repeat use, prioritize reinforced PVC, anti-slip interior, and drainage that does not require lifting.

Edge load	Compresses / shape changes	Stays firm / predictable
Claw abrasion	Low–Med	High (with reinforcement)

SIZE + MAINTENANCE (FAST)

Dog	Body length	Pool width/diam.
Small	40–50 cm	100–120 cm
Medium	60–75 cm	120–150 cm
Large	80–95 cm	150–200 cm
Multi-dog	—	+20–30% width

After use	Drain → hose rinse → remove hair
Weekly	Inspect rim/seams; check base wear
Monthly	Deep rinse; dry fully; store away from sharp edges

RED FLAGS + FINAL CHECKLIST

Red flags: rim collapses when pressed · thin fold lines · slick surface · no drain · strong odor · slides on concrete. Checklist: ■ Non-inflatable preferred · ■ Reinforced PVC ≥ 0.45 mm · ■ Stable rim · ■ Anti-slip interior · ■ Wide shallow design · ■ Bottom drain · ■ Fold-flat storage.

Surface & Placement Checklist

■ Flat area (no sharp stones) · ■ Shade option nearby · ■ Hose access · ■ Drain direction planned · ■ On concrete/deck: add rubber mat/outdoor rug · ■ Keep away from grills/tools · ■ Supervision zone clear.

Surface	What to place under pool	Why
Grass	Optional tarp (clean yard)	Reduces mud transfer
Concrete	Rubber mat / outdoor rug	Stops sliding + abrasion
Decking	Outdoor rug + corner weights	Protects boards, adds grip
Tile / indoor rinse	Non-slip mat	Prevents slipping

Safe Water Level (what works for dogs)

Dog type	Target water level	Why
First-time / nervous	Paws to lower legs	Confidence + stable footing
Everyday cooling	Lower legs to belly	Cooling without fatigue
Bathing	Low (easy control)	Less splashing, calmer dog
Puppies / seniors	Very shallow	Low strain, safer exit

Session Timing (hot weather routine)

Goal	Typical session	Stop if you see...
Cooling	10–20 min	Heavy panting, slowing down
Play	5–15 min	Overexcited jumping / slipping
Bathing	3–10 min	Stress signals (tremble/escape)
Multiple sessions/day	Short repeats	Refuses entry / anxious

Confidence Building (first week)

Day	What to do	What to avoid
1	Let dog step in/out; treat near rim	Forcing entry
2–3	Add shallow water; praise calm entry	Deep water
4–7	Short routine sessions; rinse after	Slippery soap buildup

Safety Notes (short and practical)

• Supervise at all times (even shallow water). • Use cool tap water only (no ice shock). • Rinse soap fully to prevent slipping. • Ensure an easy exit path (low rim access). • Keep nails trimmed to reduce abrasion. • Dry the pool fully before storage to reduce odor/mildew.

Troubleshooting (fast fixes)

Issue	Likely cause	Fix in 60 seconds
Pool slides	Hard surface + low friction	Add rubber mat / reduce water
Dog hesitant	Rim wobble or slippery base	Shallower water + towel dry base
Water splashes out	Too deep or excited play	Lower level; shorter sessions
Persistent odor	Not fully drained/dried	Deep rinse; sun-dry fully

Check	Pass criteria	Result
Rim stability	Does not fold under hand press	■

Odor	Low odor after unpacking	■
Drain cap	Seals; opens smoothly; no leaks	■
Fold lines	No whitening cracks after 10 folds	■
Surface texture	Anti-slip feel wet	■
Print/labels	Clear; no bleeding	■
Package set	All items present; instructions included	■

Packaging & Storage Notes

Stage	Do this	Avoid
Before packing	Dry fully; wipe hair; close drain cap	Packing wet (odor/mildew)
Warehouse storage	Keep off sharp edges; moderate temp	Heat stacking in sun
Customer storage	Fold flat; store in bag/box	Tight crease on same line

Support / Claims Triage (what to ask first)

Customer report	Ask for	Likely resolution
Leak / puncture	Photos of area + seam; usage surface	Patch / replace
Pool collapse	Video of rim load; dog size	Explain edge load; replace
Slippery base	Surface type + mat used	Recommend mat; cleaning tips
Odor complaint	How stored/dried	Deep rinse; sun-dry guidance
